Staff:

We are proud to offer an experienced, educated staff at New Salem Weekday Preschool. Staff undergo a background check, CPR and safety training. Teachers also participate in annual professional development training. We are always looking to gain more wisdom and insight as we teach each child.

Safety and Security:

We take safety and security very seriously. This includes the cleanliness of our rooms to ensure the health and wellbeing of each child. Our Preschool is locked during school hours and is monitored by Church Personnel as well as video cameras that monitor the entrance. We ID anyone who comes to pick up your child in your absence.

Curriculum:

The Christian education curriculum includes a Bible story, verse, songs, drama, rhymes, and crafts. We follow the Georgia Early Developmental Standards.

Our Program:

- 4-hour extended program
No additional "lunch bunch" fee
9:00 am To 1:00 pm
- Low child to staff ratio
- Two & three year old's do not have to be potty trained
- Children with mild to moderate social development abilities are accepted upon an evaluation
- Flexibility to adjust attendance days if needed to accommodate parents work schedule.

Infant & Toddlers:

The Infant & Toddler program is offered two days a week. We accept infants from 3 months to 23 months of age.

Preschool Program Schedule:

2 days for 3-23 months.
2-5 days for 2 year old's.
3-5 day schedule for 3 year old's.
4-5 day schedule for 4 & 5 year old's.

The school offers a specially designed class for those children who missed the August 1st cut off day and/or those entering Kindergarten the following year.
